Notes: ** The APCA recognizes that CHCs provide several services in one clinic including but not limited to primary care, dental, pharmaceutical, behavioral, and x-ray services, and that due to this centralized care a single patient visit to a CHC may be longer and more expensive than a traditional doctor's office. In a traditional doctor's office, the patient receive's primary care but goes elsewhere to receive pharmaceutical, x-ray, and other services. Therefore, the price of a single patient visit to a CHC versus a single patient visit to a doctor's office cannot be compared on a one-to-one basis.
